
Georgian pastimes: Paper boats




During Georgian times, the family at Cannon Hall used to keep a boat on the lake. How about making your own out of paper?

You will need:


A piece of A4 paper



Fold your paper in half so the short edges are on top of each other



Put the folded edge at the top and fold in each corner into the centre.



Fold the excess sticking out the bottom up.



Turn over and do the same to the other side. it will look a bit like a hat.



Push the middle out on each side with your thumbs to make a square.



Fold the bottom flap up

Georgian pastimes: Paper boats



Turn over and do the same on the other side to make a triangle



Push your thumbs inside



With your finger tips pull the two sides out



Squash down to make your boat flat



Push out the middle to make your boat 3D



Have fun floating your boat
