Roller Ball Painting

You will need:

- A tray
- Poster Paint in your teams colours
- Paper
- Balls (any type of small ball)
- Sticky tape




Line your tough tray with your choice of paper or card.
Fix with tape
Add your decorations.
Add your balls and the colours of your team.



You're ready to create your roller ball painting.
Roll the tray from side to side ...rolling the balls in the paint and running the balls all around. (It may be a team effort depending on the size of your tray. You may need adult help to move the tray from side to side)
