**ELSECAR MAY
HAVE A
LIDO**

The attraction of Elsecar, haunt of hundreds of summer visitors from the Barnsley and Rotherham districts, may be enhanced by the provision of a lido. Bathing in the reservoir, which gives the village its title of "Elsecar by the sea" was popular for many years until visitors were warned because of pollution of the water.

Yesterday, Heyland Urban Council approved a recommendation by their parks committee that details of the cost of a lido at Elsecar Park be obtained.

Tradespeople in the village are strongly in favour of the proposal. It was reported that the National Fitness Council was in favour of the Council's application for a grant towards the baths. The surveyor (Mr. J. R. Shepherd) was instructed to prepare a baths scheme less expensive than one formerly outlined.

In 1938, there were plans to design a lido for Elsecar Park-creating a safe place to bathe for visiting families.
