Dinosaur Footprints



You will need:

Thick cardboard
Scissors
Soil or sand

You've used one of the apps on your phone to make a photo or film of a dinosaur in your garden or room ready to surprise the kids, and ransacked the area to make it look authentic.

Now, how about making it seem more real by adding some roar-some footprints?



Use cardboard- like the kind used for delivery boxes to cut out your footprint.

Use your cutout as a stencil and scatter soil or sand on top to make the shape.

Now carefully lift away the stencil, taking care not to spill any excess soil/sand onto your image. Add more footprints to show the journey your dinosaur has made across the garden/ room.
