

# Barnsley Museums Makes: 'Trunk the Elephant'



You will need:

- 2 cardboard roll tubes
- 2 googly eyes (optional)
- Black paint
- White paint
- Glue
- Scissors
- Paintbrush



Make your own 'Trunk the Elephant' and bring them along to Cooper Gallery for an adventure with Elmer and friends!



Squash one of your cardboard rolls flat, giving you two layers of card.



Draw an ear shape and cut this out. Cut about 2cm off the end of the tube.



Mix some grey paint, use this to paint the tube, the two ears and the circle of card which can be cut to form the trunk.



When the paint is dry fold the edge of the ear back to make a flap and stick on to the tube.



Now add the eyes and trunk.



You could make all kinds of jungle friends for Trunk using cardboard rolls.
