

Barnsley Museums Makes: Paper Plate Elmer



You will need:

A paper plate
Scissors
Colourful tissue paper cut
or ripped into squares or
other shapes
Glue



Create and decorate your own Elmer by ripping and sticking colourful paper or simply use colouring pencils.



Draw the outline of Elmer's face onto a paper plate like this.



Cut out the two shapes, top and bottom of the plate. It should look like a giant sweetie!



Keep the bits you've cut out and stick them on to the plate to make Elmer's trunk.



Cut or rip up colourful paper to decorate Elmer with. Cover your paper plate Elmer in glue.



Stick the coloured paper all over the paper plate.



Use a black felt tip pen to draw two eyes on to Elmer's face. Now Elmer is ready for an adventure!
