You will need:


A piece of A4 paper or the template with pre-drawn boxes

A ruler and pencil (if using plain A4 paper)

Coloured crayons or felt tips




Explore and find colours that match Elmer's patchwork pattern. Use the template to help you spot the exact colours and create a mini concertina book.




Use the template or divide a piece of paper so you have 10 rectangles. Each box is around 5.5cm x 10.5cm.




In the top right corner, design your front cover and give your trail a title.



Find things in the Elmer colours (yellow, red, blue, purple, black, pink, white, green). Draw them in each box.



Top tip for later: Flip your paper after the top row and draw the bottom row so they are upside down.



Fold your paper in half along the halfway line. Starting from the front cover, fold each rectangle back and forth to create a concertina shape.



You can squish this down and use as a mini book or open out to display.
