

Winterval: Gold Rings



On the fifth day of Christmas my true love gave to me, Five gold rings...

Have you seen the 12 days of Christmas trail on our Cannon Hall Facebook page? There are lots of activities and recipes to do celebrating Christmas past Why not make a gold ring wreath to hang on your door?



Make a hoop using willow, hazel or grapevine branches or a loop of garden wire.



Start by threading in your greenery to make a good base. If you are using a wire hoop just secure using garden wire.



Tie ribbon at four points around your wreath. This will make everything more secure and will look pretty too.

You will need:

Bits of evergreen foliage from the garden, found on a winter walk or from a florist Secateurs Thin garden wire Gold spray paint Wire cutters Ribbons



Carry on threading in your greenery until you have a good thick ring of foliage.





Hang on your door to add festive cheer to passersby.







Add bright berries, rosehips or pine cones for colour. When you are happy with your wreath use gold spray paint to add a gold accent for extra glamour.
