

If you visit Cannon Hall this winter you might see a beautiful display of snowflakes and dancers. Why not have a go at making your snowflake dancer display at home?



White card or paper A piece of A4 white paper Sticky tape Scissors A bit of thread to hang it up A pencil or pen



Draw a dancing person on paper or card. Remember to include a tutu as it will help the skirt stick out better.



She might look a bit like this.





Take an A4 piece of white paper and fold one edge over to make a triangle with a rectangle sticking out. Cut off the rectangle shape and you will be left with a square.





Carry on folding your square piece of paper in half until you have a cheese. Now cut out shapes, triangles and circles along the folds. Fold out and you will have a snowflake.



Carefully make a slit in the middle of your snowflake and push the top of the dancer through it. Use a little bit of tape inside to secure in place.



Hang your beautiful dancer in your window or on your tree and see it dance in the breeze
