11 pipers piping...

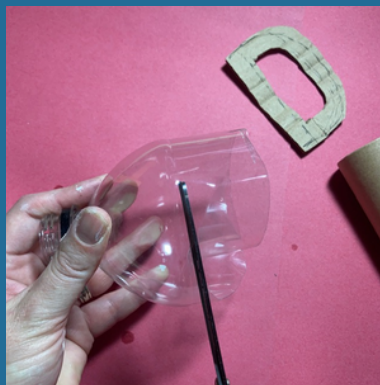
Have you seen the 11 days of Christmas trail on our Cannon Hall Facebook page and website? There are lots of activities and recipes to do celebrating Christmas past  
Why not make a shiny silver trumpet?

You will need:

Tin foil  
Plastic empty pop bottle  
Scissors  
Cardboard tube  
Sticky tape  
Pen or pencil  
Glue  
Thick card



Gather all your materials needed together.  
Cut the thick card into a D shape- ask a grown up to cut out the bit in the middle.



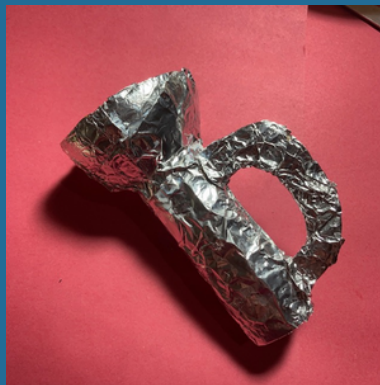
Cut out the funnel of your pop bottle. An adult might need to do this bit.



Tape on your funnel to your tube and then tape on your D shaped handle.



Use glue and small bits of silver foil to cover your trumpet all over.



Carry on until it is completely covered and then leave to dry.
