ADVENTURES IN STORYLAND STIRRING SEA SPOON PUPPETS

- You will need:
- A wooden spoon
 - Glue
 - Pencil
 - Scissors
 - A lollipop stick or similar
 - Paper, felt, foam or cardboard
 - Wool or coloured string (optional)
 - Googly eyes or stickers (optional)
 - Ballpoint pens or colouring pencils



On the back of your wooden spoon, attach or draw on some eyes and add facial features. Beards and hats can be created from paper, cardboard, foam or felt.



Use a lollipop stick or similar to create arms. If making an outfit it is best to glue or attach your stick at the front of your puppet, on the top of the spoon's handle.



Cut out and create an outfit for your spoon-puppet using paper, card, foam or felt. It is useful to draw round the arms and body to get an idea of shape and sizing. When you are happy with your outfit, glue in place.



Alternatively, wrap and tie wool round the body to make clothes as with the mermaid puppet.



Hair can be made by cutting long strips of wool, folding them in half and sticking to the spoon with glue. Once fully dry you can style or plait the hair.
