



THE IMAGINARIUM

ADVENTURES IN STORYLAND STAR TWIRLER

- You will need:
- A paper plate
 - Purple paint
 - Paintbrush/ Waterpot
 - Yellow paper or card
 - Some kitchen foil
 - Scissors
 - Glue
 - String
 - Stapler
 - Any decorative bits, eg, stars and sequins



Paint the front of your paper plate and leave to dry.



Whilst the plate dries, make your stars. Drawing two triangles over each other makes a good star shape, add faces and cut out some foil stars too. (It helps to double up the foil to make the stars stronger.)



Paint the back of your plate purple and leave to dry whilst you finish your stars.



Turn the plate over and cut out a swirl snail shape, you might need to trim it after. It's a good idea to practise the cutting out on the spare plate.



Decorate your swirl by sticking on the stars and any extra decoration bits you like.



Cut a piece of string and staple to the top of the swirl, now you are ready to display it. They look lovely in a window where the light can reflect on the foil stars.


