



# Barnsley Museums Makes: Adventure Stick

Have you been to Worsbrough Mill & Country Park to spot the birds on our 'Winter Bird Walk' trail yet?

Why not remember your walk by creating an adventure stick? Collect natural items you find on the path as you walk along. Remember to collect only fallen items and be careful not to pick any poisonous plants or leaves - ask an adult if you are unsure.

You will need:

A stick

Yarn or string

Things you find on your walk - fallen leaves, seed pods and feathers etc.

Beads



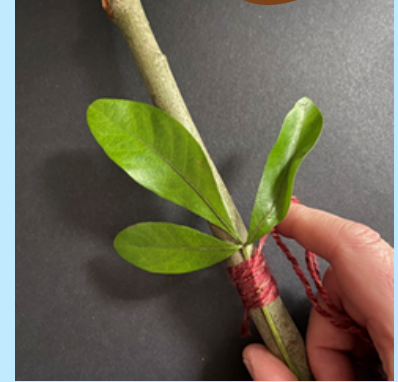

Look around on the floor and find a stick. Not too long, not too short and make sure it is strong.



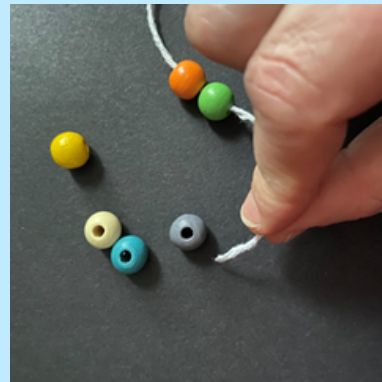
Spread out all the things you found on your walk. Think about where you might like to put them on your stick.



Hold your items onto your stick whilst you wrap yarn or string, firmly around them.



Some items may be a bit trickier than others to attach so you may need someone to help you.



You can also use beads to add colour to your stick. You could pick ones that match the colours of the things you see and find.



Once you have finished attaching all of your objects, use your Journey Stick to tell someone the story of your walk and what the things are on your stick.
