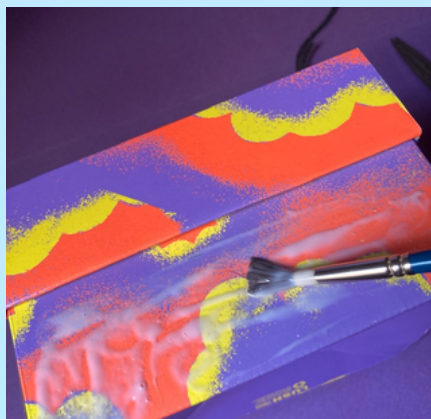

You will need:

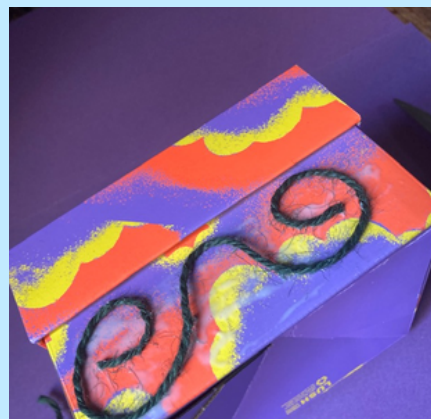
- A box
- PVA glue
- A glue spreader
- String
- Scissors
- Paint
- Paint brush



Find a box with a lid - a shoe box would work well.



Spread on some PVA glue.



Stick string to the glue- this could be curly whirly or straight lines. Leave it to dry.



Paint your box - I've painted mine gold.



Make it look old by 'dry brushing' brown paint on it. This is using paint without any water - it gives a rough effect.



Why not put treasure in your box?
