


Welcome to Cannon Hall

From the pre-Raphaelite inspired romantic magic of Fairyland to the glorious historic pear tree collection in our walled garden, Cannon Hall offers a truly unique backdrop for your special day.

The Ballroom

With features such as the Minstrels'
Gallery and the grand Florentine fireplace, the Ballroom is a breath-taking space for your ceremony. Built in 1891 for the wedding reception of John Montague Spencer-Stanhope, the Ballroom reflects the regal beauty of the Hall, with Jacobean oak panels, floorboards and Minstrels' Gallery all made by carpenters here on the estate. Complete with grand piano and stunning double door entrance, the ballroom can seat up to 80 guests on antique wash Chiavari chairs.







The Deer Shelter

Nestled within the parklands and surrounded by stunning historic rhododendrons, the 19th century Deer Shelter offers the perfect atmosphere for a romantic outdoor ceremony. Flanked by decorative arched windows on the outer gables and fronted by four rustic yew pillars, the internal beams and exposed stone walls provide the ultimate backdrop for your unique style.

The Deer Shelter seats up to 60 guests seated on wooden benches, antique wash Chiavari chairs can be provided for guests that require them.







The Walled Garden

The Walled Garden offers a tranquil, romantic backdrop to your wedding ceremony. What better place to say your vows than in an outdoor ceremony surrounded by a sweeping natural backdrop of historic pear trees, grape vines and beautiful glasshouses.

The Walled Garden seats up to 60 guests seated on wooden benches, antique wash Chiavari chairs can be provided for guests that require them. Wedding parties may have 2 hours exclusive use of the garden, excluding the kiosk courtyard.



Wedding receptions

From May to September, we offer land hire so you can continue your party into the evening and enjoy the spectacular sunsets over the parklands. The tennis courts provide an idyllic spot to pitch a tipi/marquee for a wedding reception, allowing you to make the most of our beautiful views and party the night away.

Questions & answers

How long can we have use of the venue?

We can provide a drinks reception after your ceremony on an hourly basis. Photographs around the parkland are encouraged. For land hire receptions, your DJ or your acoustic band can play until 11.30pm, and last orders must be called at 11:10pm. Guests must vacate the tipi by 12 midnight.

What are our catering options?

Your chosen tipi/marquee company may have some recommendations for caterers. We also work with several recommended suppliers to provide a varied option of catering for your day.

Can we have live music?

You are welcome to have live acoustic music for your ceremony or reception. A grand piano is available to hire for Ballroom ceremonies.

Can we bring our own alcohol?

Our team can provide a full drinks reception after your ceremony.
Alternatively, if you would like to provide your own alcohol, we can chill & serve for a small corkage fee.

Are your ceremony spaces licenced for civil ceremonies?

The Deer Shelter, Walled Gardens and Ballroom are licenced for civil ceremonies.


Is car parking available?
